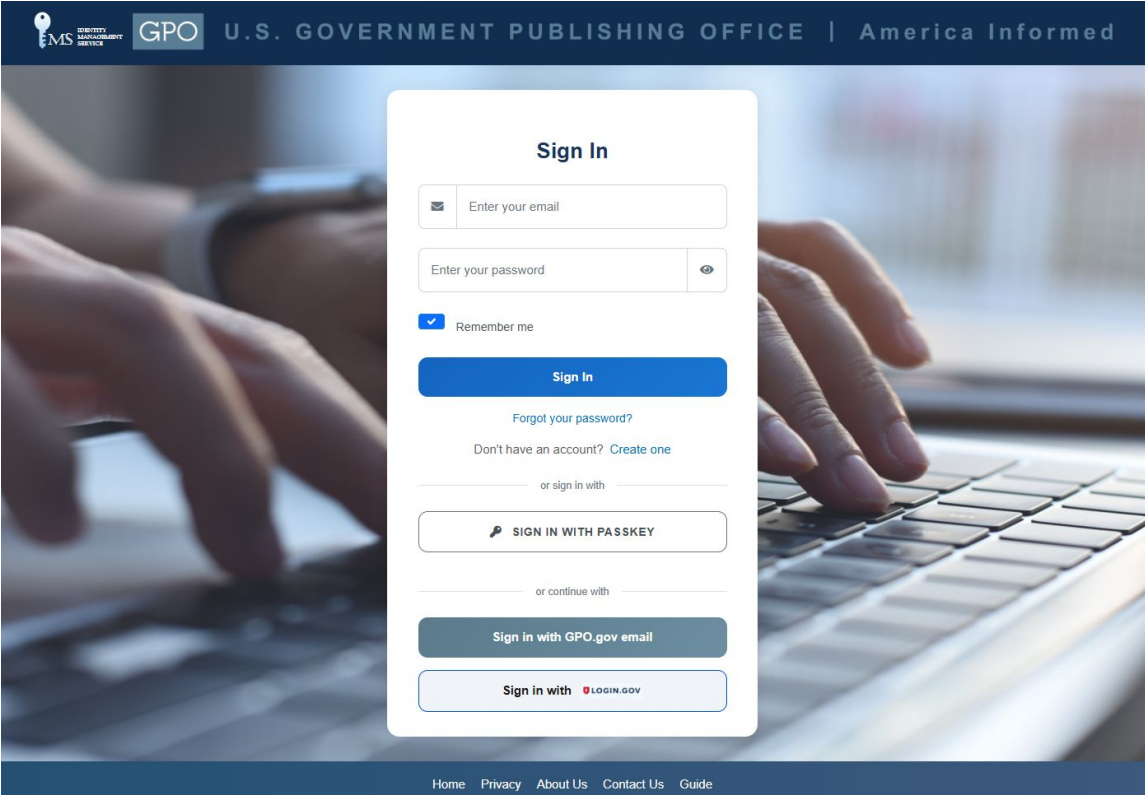
1. Select GPO Email Option

STEP 1

Accessing Portal via SSO

Follow these steps to log in using your official domain email address:

- Go to the main GPO IMS homepage and click **Login / Sign In**.
- Instead of entering a local password, scroll to the bottom of the sign-in card.
- Locate and click the button labeled **"Login using gpo.gov email"**.
- This redirects you to the secure organizational single sign-on screen.
